Fun Fact about the Saint John's Bible

The use of only organic tools and materials was used in the calligraphy process. Three kinds of quills were used; goose quills for most of the calligraphy, and swan and turkey quills for the heavier lettering. The team of scribes used natural handmade inks, hand-ground pigments, and gold and silver leaf gild. Letters were written in lamp black ink from 19th century Chinese stick inks made from carbon.

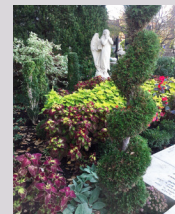
