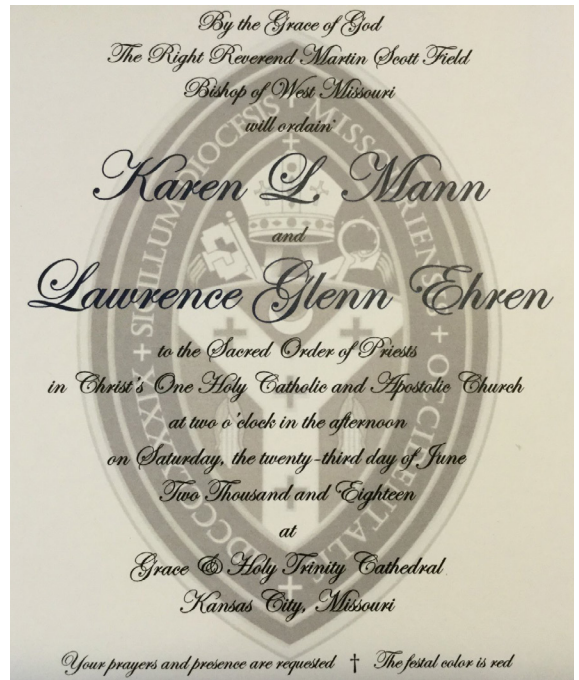
From me to you ...
