# Did You Know?



## Fun Fact about the Saint John's Bible

In 1998, Saint John's Abbey and University commissioned renowned calligrapher and Chief Scribe to the Queen of England, Donald Jackson, to produce a hand-written, hand-illuminated Bible. The first volume, the Gospels and Acts, was delivered in May 2001. The last volume, Letters and Revelations, was delivered in 2011, marking an almost 10 year development process. *The Saint John's Bible* is the first completely handwritten and illuminated Bible commissioned by a Benedictine Abbey since the invention of the printing press.

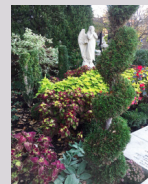
