Thank you all for your participation in the conversations with the Bishop last weekend about the Dean Search process. If you have additional questions about the transition time and search process, I'd love to chat with you about those.



The Vestry met this past week in special session to consider how to fill the seat opened by Bob Carlson's resignation. During the meeting, I announced that I have appointed Paula Connors to serve as Senior Warden. Paula has been a member of and served at the Cathedral for more than two decades. She is experienced with times of transition, having served on two Dean Search Committees, and will bring all of that caring and experience to bear in the days to come. In addition, Paula is a person of deep prayer and thoughtfulness and her deep spirituality will greatly aid the work of the Vestry. The Vestry elected Sharon Cheers to serve the remainder of Bob's term. Sharon will join the Vestry August 1. Sharon has been a long-time member of the Cathedral and loves to serve in this place. The Vestry also began planning for the Cathedral Small Group Conversations to happen this fall and the selection of a Dean Search Committee. Please continue to keep them in your prayers as they lead at the Cathedral.
