## Fun Fact about the Saint John's Bible

The Committee on Illumination and Text, a group of art historians, medievalists, artists, biblical scholars and theologians convened at Saint John's University, presented Donald Jackson with briefs and abstracts for the scripture illuminations. This group acted as clients for the work, offering direction and approving final sketches, as well as receiving the pages as each of the seven volumes was completed. *The Saint John's Bible* contains the text and notes of the New Revised Standard Version translation. This translation was chosen because it is theologically sound and approved by a large number of Christian denominations.
