Did You Know?



Fun Fact about the Saint John's Bible

From the time he was a child, Donald Jackson dreamed of creating a handwritten, illuminated Bible like the ones he saw at the British Library. Donald Jackson entered art school when he was 13, and he subsequently became an internationally renowned calligrapher and official scribe to Queen Elizabeth II. In 1995, while at Saint John's University presenting at a calligraphy conference, he witnessed the monks of Saint John's Abbey and University processing with the Book of Gospels during liturgy and thought that these monks might be interested in partnering in his long dreamed of Bible project. This was in many ways a natural partnership as the early Benedictines, in their scriptoriums, produced and preserved some of the greatest texts of Western Civilization.
