Did You Know?



Fun Fact about the Saint John's Bible

The Saint John's Bible reflects Benedictine values, particularly highlighting three themes: hospitality, conversion of life and justice for God's people. Additionally, gold leaf was used liberally to represent the divine, silver/platinum to reflect the principle of wisdom, and rainbows to show God's promise in the vivid illuminations in the volumes Prophets and Revelation. Inked stamps, textile patterns and other motifs carry themes across volumes. Most of the margin illustrations of butterflies, other insects, plant life and wildlife are native to Minnesota and North Central states, reflecting the home of Saint John's University and Abbey in Collegeville, Minnesota. A wide range of artistic styles, including iconography, abstraction, chrysography and illustration, work together to expand our visual vocabulary for the sacred.
