in September, the Cathedral will begin offering weekday Holy Eucharist at 12:05 p.m. on Wednesdays only! There will be no services offered other weekdays. We will be asking for feedback from attendees on the change, so if you attend the weekday service, please let us know your opinion.

## A Summer of Gratitude

A very special thanks to all in the congregation who have donated diapers, school supplies and basic hygiene products this summer! In the June Diaper Drive for HappyBottoms, outreach collected 2,141 diapers. We are just 4,315 diapers away from our goal of 10,000 for the year. In the July School Supply Drive, outreach collected 1,287 school supplies for the children in foster care and residential care at Crittenton Children's Center. Dozens of hotel sample products and 771 hygiene products were collected in August for the non-profit "Giving the Basics." We will use the hotel samples to make hygiene kits for St. Mary's or St. Pauls in KCK. In the coming months, please remember to bring non-perishable food for St. Mary's pantry. Our Cathedral has only donated one-third of the two tons of food that is our 2018 goal.
