## The Reverend Jerry Grabher

Deacon Jerry was ordained and commissioned as a missionary of the United Methodist Church September 14, 1969. He attended several universities, eventually receiving his Master of Divinity and Master of Christian Education degrees. His journey has taken him to the Belgian Congo, other parts of Africa and the Philippines. He has served at Countryside UMC in Topeka, on the Conference Staff of the Kansas East Conference, as Director of the National UMC Camp Conference Board and Director of Spectrum Resource—Camp Conference Consultants. Upon retirement, he returned to Kansas City and attended St. Mary's Episcopal Church. On August 27, 2001, he was ordained a Deacon in the Episcopal Church and came to Grace and Holy Trinity Cathedral November 7, 2010.
