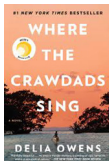


## Readers Book Club

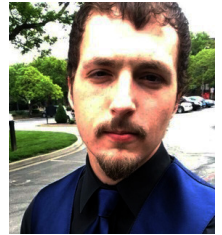


## BackSnack Delivery Drivers Needed!
